SRTC Seeks Transportation Advisory Committee Members

The Spokane Regional Transportation Council (SRTC) is seeking members for its Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC). The TAC is a citizens' advisory group responsible for advising the SRTC Board on policy recommendations regarding plans, programs, and activities conducted by SRTC. The purpose of the TAC is to promote transparency and provide an opportunity for the public to be involved in SRTC's programs.

The TAC is composed of 13 members that meet on a monthly basis. Selected members should reflect the diversity of modal and policy expertise and constituent groups with a direct connection to local transportation planning. Each of the Transportation Advisory Committee members must be able to read and understand the fundamentals of land use and transportation planning as established in the Revised Code of Washington.

TAC members will be chosen based on their credentials and will serve three-year staggered terms.
