The project will look at all modes of transportation - transit, bicycling, walking, personal vehicles, freight, etc. - within Spokane County.

In this roundtable meeting, Vision Project staff would like to meet with families and parents of children. As many parents are now driving their children to school when they live within walking or bicycling distance, we would like to gather input on the current transportation system and the challenges it poses to children and their safety.
