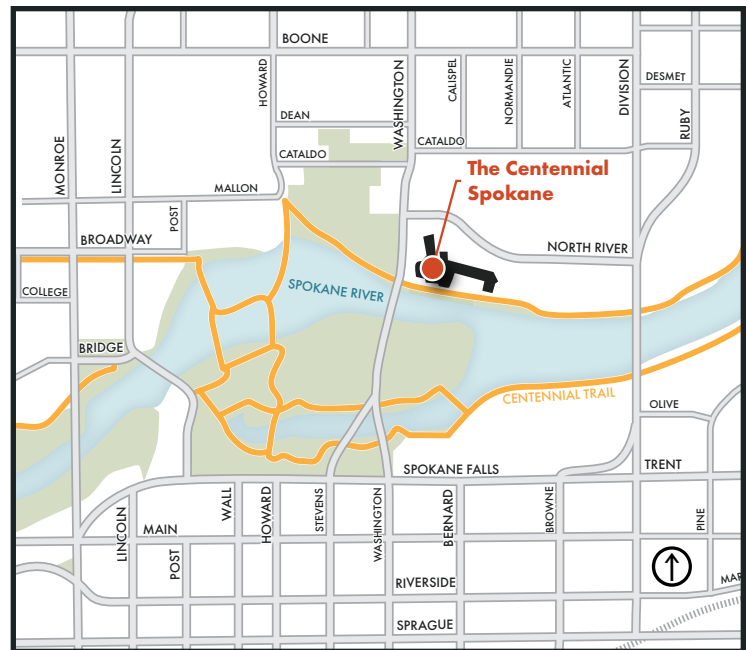
Day 2: Thursday, July 11 8:00 A.M.–4:30 P.M.
